

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
The Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Inc.
and
The Institution of Electrical Engineers (IEE)**

To encourage the exchange and dissemination of technical information, and to promote understanding and cooperation between the members of the Institution of Electrical Engineers (IEE) and the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Inc. (IEEE), it is hereby agreed to the following reciprocal arrangements.

1. VISITING MEMBERS

Visiting members from the aforementioned professional organizations will be granted equivalent facilities to those granted to local members.

In effect this will enable such visitors to take advantage of special member rates for attending lectures and conferences and to use the library, members' reading room and other facilities.

The Secretary/General Manager of the parent Institution will, on request, provide a letter of introduction and confirm the membership of the visiting member.

2. JOINT ACTIVITIES

Members resident in the territory of the other organization for longer than one (1) year will be encouraged to join each other's organization.

3. COORDINATION OF TECHNICAL MEETINGS

Invitations to cosponsor conferences or other events will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

To the maximum extent practicable, consultation shall take place when it is proposed to conduct conferences or similar events in the United Kingdom by IEEE, and in the United States by IEE.

4. PUBLICATIONS EXCHANGE

Members of one organization may receive certain publications of the other organization at reduced rates of subscription.

(a) Periodicals for which a reduced subscription rate are available to one organization's members, will be available to the other organization's members at a reduction of 20% of the non-member rates.

(b) Single copy publications, for which a reduced price is available to one organization's members, will be available to the other organization's members at a reduction of 20% of the non-member rate.

By mutual agreement certain publications will be exchanged between IEE and IEEE. A current listing will be maintained in a supplement to this Agreement.

5. STANDARDS INFORMATION

IEEE and IEE agree to exchange information on their respective standards activities, and agree to encourage mutual participation in standards development.

6. REVIEW, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

Amendments to the agreement may be proposed at any time, but will not be valid until they have been approved by both the IEEE and IEE.


Other cooperative agreements, which may be made in the future, shall be documented in a supplement to this agreement.


The term of this agreement shall be for a fixed duration of three (3) years, from 1 January 2006 to 31 December 2008, subject to termination by both parties on three months notice in writing. Renewal is contingent upon approval by both institutions.

This agreement comes into force by the signature of both parties.
